

German tests and certificates that are sufficient for admission to a degree programme for which level B2 (according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) is required:

- the German Language Diploma of the Standing Conference of the Ministers of Education and Cultural Affairs of the Länder of the Federal Republic of Germany - Second Level -.
- the Small or the Large German Language Diploma of the Goethe-Institut
- the certificate of the Zentrale Oberstufenprüfung (ZOP) of the Goethe-Institut
- the Goethe-Zertifikat B2 or higher from the Goethe-Institut
- the certificate of the German Language Examination for the Admission of Foreign Study Applicants (DSH level 1)
- the certificate of the Test Deutsch als Fremdsprache für ausländische Studienbewerber (TestDaF) (German as a Foreign Language for Foreign Study Applicants) with a result that shows at least level 3 in all four sub-tests
- the certificate on the examination to determine the aptitude of foreign applicants to study at universities in the Federal Republic of Germany (Feststellungsprüfung);
- the telc certificate German B2 or higher
- a degree in German studies abroad
- Proof of German language proficiency that has been recognised by bilateral agreements or other agreements made by the KMK or HRK as sufficient proof of language proficiency for admission to a higher education programme.
